TO THE DEN OF THE PIPER CUB

For many non-pilots, the phrase "Piper Cub" is synonymous with small airplanes. For many pilots, the Cub is the ancestor of today's general aviation. The Piper Aircraft factory in Lock Haven turned out thousands of these yellow wonders, along with all the earlier Piper planes. After a devastating flood caused by Hurricane Agnes in 1972, all production moved to Vero Beach, FL. The original factory is now a museum of Piper aircraft and history. On Sunday, August 29, we will visit this aviation shrine. A 101 nm flight over some of Pennsylvania's most scenic terrain brings us to Piper Memorial Airport (KLHV). Other than snack machines, there is no food available at the museum, nor is there a restaurant within convenient distance. Therefore, bring lunch. Picnic tables are available.

We'll gather at Penn Airways at 1030 for 1100 takeoff. The museum opens at noon, so we can make full use of the facilities. Take a non-pilot along, for an introduction to the world of general aviation—the fun and camaraderie.
