Get Crabby with PAOP

Well, not in your attitude, but in your sights for a seafood lunch on the shore of the Chesapeake. June 26 is the time for our annual flight to the land of the Maryland blue crab, steamed and spiced, with the succulent meat picked out by your own hand. Kentmorr Marina, a charming development on Kent Island, MD, features an airport, a beach, and a restaurant. The restaurant features both indoor service and an outdoor deck. There's an extensive menu of seafood choices, and even a burger or two. Check it out at www.kentmorr.com.

The restaurant is just a short walk from our flight destination at Kentmorr Airpark (3W3), a pretty, residential airport on the Eastern Shore's Kent Island, a few miles south of the Chesapeake Bay Bridge. This delightful spot is served by a 2,400 foot (displaced thresholds make it 2,200 feet for landing), well-tended grass airport. The airport's web site also has the current procedures for flying in. On the predictable warm day, you will want to be current on density altitude, and on short and soft field procedures. We'll be in contact with the airport manager for a last minute update on the condition of the field.

visit. It's an easy trip down the east side of the Bay, with little concern about the Special Flight Rules Area (formerly known as the ADIZ). However, you must not stray across the bay, lest you get a close-up view of some Coast Guard helicopters.

IMPORTANT As this flight takes you within 60 nm of the DCA VORTAC, pilots required to have taken the special online course, available on the FAA web site. (www.aopa.org/adizfaa)

Local Information

Allentown (KABE) Frequency Change

On June 30th, 2011, Allentown Approach will lose frequency 118.2 MHz. This has been their frequency for aircraft at 3000 ft. and below for many years. They will begin transitioning to the use of frequency 119.65 MHz for 3000 ft and below about mid-June; check the Automatic Terminal Information Service (ATIS) at Lehigh Valley International Airport. Above 3000 ft will continue to be 124.45 MHz for all of Allentown approach airspace, both North and South of KABE.

Databases are being updated. Notices to Airmen (NOTAMs), if appropriate, will be issued.

The New York Sectional is not expected to be updated until the November 2011 issue.
