Blairstown, NJ, started as a settlement in 1729, ultimately growing through the efforts of several farming, milling, and trading families. The Blairs arrived in 1822, building a successful chain of general stores, with the town being renamed in their honor in 1839. Today, Blairstown serves as a cultural and economic hub for several small surrounding communities.

Blairstown Airport (1N7) hosts the very pleasant Runway Café, our brunch destination for the November 24 flyout. It boasts a 3007 x 70 foot runway, surrounded by some impressive, wooded hills. Additional caution is called for by an active glider operation on the south side of the runway.

It will be a comfortable 51 nm jaunt past Allentown and over some of central New Jersey's attractive landscape.

We'll gather at Penn Airways at 1000 for 1030 takeoff. Take a non-pilot or a student

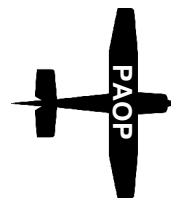

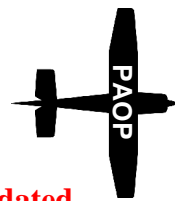
