## Flyout

### SPRING INTO THE POCONOS

Traditionally one of our fall flyouts, going to Cherry Ridge (N30) should bring some spectacular views of fall foliage. On October 27, we'll take the 78 nm jaunt over some of our state's most scenic areas.

The nearest town is Honesdale, site of the first commercial operation of a steam train in the United States. Located in a coal mining region, during the 19th century it was the starting point of the Delaware and Hudson Canal, which ultimately brought coal to New York City. Today, it's home to history, shopping, and outdoor sports.

The tidy restaurant provides a panoramic view overlooking the runway, with friendly staff who serves up a tasty breakfast or savory lunch.

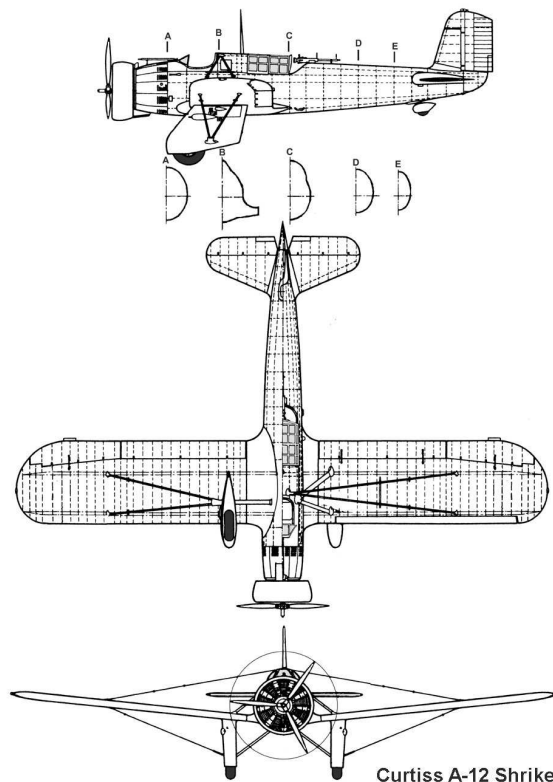
Practice up on your short field takeoffs. While the runway is 2,420 feet long, the elevation is 1,357 feet, so you might have to

think about density altitude, especially if we get one of those warm, mid-fall days.

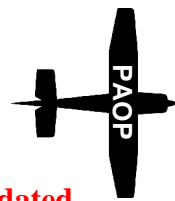


Curtiss A-12 Shrike
